Check in/Registration– Collect participant envelopes, distribute banners, tickets, and bracelets, and provide information about the walk.

Directionals/Walk Marshalls– Direct people to the correct areas of parking, registration and throughout the festival; also along the walk route.

Food/Refreshments– Help Organize and serve refreshments to participants before and after the event.
