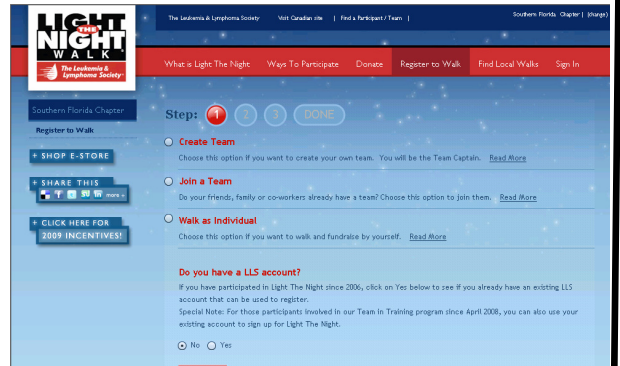


# Registration for 2010 Walks Open!
